PRINCIPAL'S ACTIVITIES REPORT (2010 - 2011)**

1. CCSC ALUMNI FOUNDATION FUND OUTSTANDING SERVICE AWARD

2009/10 Awardees: Choi Yuen Tsing (S4C), Cheung Mei Yi (S4D), Lam Chi Tak (S6A) and Ng Joseph Cho Yiu (S6B), each received a book coupon of \$400

2010/11 Awardees: Siu Wing Tung (S3A), Kwan Hiu Lam (S4C), Chu Hoi Tik (S5A) and Lai Man Sin (S5A), each to receive a book coupon of \$400 in 2011/12 school year

2. CCSC ALUMNI FOUNDATION FUND COMMENDABLE SERVICE AWARD

2009/10 Awardees: Kwok Kwun Fung (S3B), Kwan Hiu Lam (S3D), Siu Ka Yee (S4B) and Siu Sheung Yuen (S4B), each received a book coupon of \$200

2010/11 Awardees: Luk Wing Lam (S3B), Li Ching Yee (S3E), Siu Sheung Yuen (S5A) and Siu Ka Yee (S5B), each to receive a book coupon of \$200 in 2011/12 school year

3. CCSC SAGE ELDER ACADEMY

i) 230 S1 - S6 students participated in a green handicraft course, a Facebook course, a basic computer course and 2 photo-editing courses for a total of 37 elders.

Subsidies used for buying tools and materials for making recycle paper and soap = \$724

ii) 6 students joined the Christmas programme with 12 elders.

Subsidies used for buying Christmas hats = \$100

4. SERVICE LEARNING TRIP TO CHINA (岩背學習交流體驗營)

17 S4 and S5 students led by Mr. Tong Ling Poon, Miss Kong Tsui Yan and Miss Kwok Yuen Ching will go to Yan Bei, Guangdong from 14 – 19 August 2011, teaching the local junior secondary students English and IT.

Subsidies to be used for the trip = \$5,000

5. COMMUNITY SERVICES

i) Fun Fair from 28 – 30 September 2010 to promote the activities of Community Services Student Team for the whole school.

Subsidies used for decorating display board = \$141.40

ii) From October 2010 to March 2011, 42 S2 - S6 students visited and interviewed the isolated elders co-organized with Hong Kong Lutheran Social Service, Harmony Garden Lutheran Centre for the Elderly (香港路德會社會服務處 路德會富欣花園長者中心) and published the "Journal of Life".

Subsidies used for buying materials for making desserts with elders and drinks for visits to elders = \$109.80

iii) 38 S1 - S6 students participated in a visit to the visually impaired and blind on 18 December 2010 co-organized with the Hong Kong Lutheran Social Service, Shek Kip Mei Lutheran Centre for the Blind (香港路德會社會服務處 路德會石硤尾失明者中心).

Subsidies used for buying materials for making desserts with the blind and materials for games = \$449.50

iv) 17 S1 - S5 students participated in two Fun Day for the Children of Down Syndrome in July 2011 organized with the Hong Kong Down Syndrome Association (香港唐氏綜合症協會).

Subsidies used for buying materials for games and making desserts = \$703.80

9. DRAMAS WITH MORAL VALUES

i) “一屋寶貝” - Drama by Actors' Family

Synopsis: 父親朝晴最喜愛收集蝴蝶標本。為了捕捉象徵幸福的大鳳蝶，他到遠方的森林去，卻遲遲不歸。自小失去母親的女兒小雨，在家中等候得心急如焚，非常寂寞；幸得鄰居曉子照料與關懷，日子一天一天的過去……一個雨夜，失蹤多時的父親突然回家；之後，鬼靈精怪的事件接踵而來，朝晴卻不知如何應對！正當他們為小雨憂心忡忡，屋中幽靈紛至，在蛻變的時間、空間，在他們迷離而奇妙的故事背後，真正能為小雨帶來幸福的未來徐徐展開...

ii) “留守太平間” - Drama by Chung Ying Theatre Company

Synopsis: 安哥拉持續三十六年的內戰，令數以十萬計的人飽受饑餓威脅。自一九八三年起，「無國界醫生」在那裡工作，提供有效的救援行動，進入偏遠而得不到援助之地，去協助那些受戰火及自然災害蹂躪的災民脫離困境。故事描述一所遭叛軍突襲的臨時醫院裡，資深的外科醫生李學仁醫生，與一名曾在大學醫學院因品行欠佳被停學的年輕工程師 Jeff，兩人同時被困於太平間，目睹遊離鬼門關的病人，他們在放棄與堅持之間徘徊，頓悟出人生哲理。

12 students attended; subsidies used = \$360

iii) “The Cove” - Drama by Oceanic Preservation Society

Synopsis: The Cove tells the amazing true story of how an elite team of activists, film makers and freedivers embarked on a covert mission to penetrate a hidden cove in Japan, shining light on a dark and deadly secret. The shocking discoveries they uncovered were only the tip of the iceberg.

11 students attended; subsidies used = \$370
